NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that there are currently two (2) vacancies on the Board of Directors of Oak Valley Hospital District, a California Local Health Care District. The vacancies were created by the resignation of Director Francis Krieger on April 8, 2026, and Director Dr. Edward Chock on April 11, 2026.

All members of the Board of Directors must reside within the boundaries of the Health Care District and be registered voters in Stanislaus County. The District has recently adopted a Zone-Based Election System for the Election of Members of the Board of Directors commencing in November, 2026. Consistent with the spirit of that recent change, we encourage applicants who reside within Zones 1 or 3, as depicted on the District map accompanying this notice.

The Board of Directors of the District intends to make an appointment to fill the vacant Board seats at the next regular meeting of the Board, as follows:

The term of this appointment will continue until the next general election in November 2026. At that time, the seats will be placed before the voters for election to serve a new four (4) year term as a representative of Zones 1 and 3 on the attached map.
